

MSF Switzerland (MSF-CH) JOB VACANCY — RADIO OPERATOR

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, humanitarian, non-governmental organisation providing assistance to people in need as a result of natural and man-made disasters, irrespective of race, religion, ideology or politics.

MSF Switzerland (MSF-CH) is currently seeking to employ a qualified candidate for the following position with initial **3** months Service Agreement, renewable.

Position: Radio OperatorLocation: Damascus, Syria

Scope of responsibilities:

Operate VHF and HF radios according to MSF security protocols to ensure safe, reliable, and confidential communication for mission and project needs.

Main tasks:

- Operate HF and VHF radios while avoiding any sensitive or security-related content, following MSF security rules.
- Ensure radio frequencies (HF and VHF) are working well, and transmission quality is strong. Install and program frequencies when needed.
- Ensure messages are clearly sent and received by all relevant people, record them in the radio logbook, and forward messages from approved organizations.
- Maintain regular radio contact with base locations (capital and/or field), sharing information to ensure team safety, and report to the Project/Capital Coordinator.
- Monitor and record all movement of people, vehicles, helicopters, planes, and cargo (departure, arrival, number of passengers, routes, contact points, etc.) in the logbook.
- Supervise and monitor the use of VHF radios (handsets), track delays, and register handset loans to staff, following up regularly.
- Install and check radio equipment to ensure it's working properly. Report any damage, loss, or theft to the line manager.
- Keep the radio equipment, communication room, and HF/VHF batteries clean, safe, and well-maintained.
- Provide basic radio training to MSF staff when needed.
- Follow up on vehicle and staff movement between cities.
- Regularly test communication and tracking equipment.
- Carry out any other tasks assigned by the direct supervisor.

Recruitment criteria

Education:

Secondary education is essential, a higher education is desirable.

Experience:

- Minimum of 2 years' experience as radio operator is essential.
- Previous experience with MSF or another NGO is desirable.

Languages:

Good written and spoken English and Arabic languages essential.

Competencies:

- Basic knowledge on mathematics, mechanical, electronic principles
- Proficient in using HF and VHF radios
- Understanding of frequency allocation and signal propagation
- Troubleshooting and maintenance of radio equipment
- Basic knowledge of IT and Networking
- Clear and concise communication, along with good listening skills
- Commitment to MSF Principles
- Behavioral Flexibility
- Stress Management
- Results and Quality Orientation
- Teamwork and Cooperation
