Introduction about MSF:

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) / أطباء بلا حدود is an international, independent, medical humanitarian organization that delivers emergency aid to people in 70 countries who are affected by armed conflict, epidemics, natural disasters and exclusion from healthcare. MSF offers assistance to people based on need, irrespective of race, religion, gender or political affiliation and our actions are guided by medical ethics and the principles of neutrality and impartiality.

We offer basic healthcare, perform surgery, fight epidemics, rehabilitate and run hospitals and clinics, carry out vaccination campaigns, operate nutrition centers, and provide mental healthcare. Our activities include the treatment of injuries and disease, maternal care and the provision of humanitarian aid. Where necessary, we set up sanitation systems, supply safe drinking water, and distribute relief to assist survival.

Main Objective of the position:

Prepare, provide and present health education sessions to the population/patients according MSF principles and values in order to promote health information through health measures and hygiene conditions as well as provide information about MSF activities in order to facilitate access to healthcare.



Accountabilities:

- Prepare material and deliver health education sessions, messages and topics addressed to different populations regarding hygiene, diseases, and prevention.
- Ensure all the patients and caretakers are well informed, according to protocols, about health related issues and services provided.
- Monitor health situation and living conditions of the population by conducting nutritional screening, collecting information related to food security, checking vaccination status of children, looking actively for any defaulters in programs that require this type of research, collecting information on number of people arriving or leaving the community, births and deaths in the community, etc.
- Identify people with medical problems, contact with medical team and report for immediate transfer if needed. He/she has to inform to the line manager about any problem encountered (population, equipment, material...).
- Report to line manager of all results of screening and visits on a regular basis.

MSF Section/Context Specific Accountabilities:

- Perform individual or group sessions focusing on health education among patients and beneficiaries availing MSF's medical services at the mobile clinic units in Latakia
- Provide Information, Education and communication (IEC) materials to the beneficiaries as part of the health education initiative, as per MSF's standards
- Assist the beneficiaries with the patient flow within the mobile clinic points in Latakia
- Carry out patient satisfaction survey and other qualitative surveys needed to improve medical services delivery at the mobile clinic points in Latakia
- Communicating regularly with the Nursing Team Supervisor for feedback regarding routine activities, challenges, and updates.
- Participating in meetings with the Nurse team Supervisor, nursing activity Manager and any other departments when requested
- Participate in capacity building initiatives organized by MSF to improve quality of healthcare services delivery at project/ mission level
- Collecting daily HP data and submitting it to NTS at the end of the day. Data collection and reporting follows MSF's standards
- Reporting timely any incidents in the field including environmental health concerns and potential outbreaks to the Nurse Team Supervisor.
- Contributing in the mapping of other actors/NGOs working in our catchment area.
- Be the back up of rest of CHE colleagues if requested
- Be flexible for any new or delegated tasks from line managers



Education	- Diploma in Higher/ Secondary Education is essential. Any social science or mental health related certifications/diploma is desirable
Experience	- Minimum 1 year work experience in health promotion/community engagement. Experience working with INGOs is desirable
Language Skills	- Arabic essential, English desirable
