## **Objectives of the position:**

Organizing and supervising the daily supply chain activities and the teams associated, in the coordination or project level, according to MSF protocols and standards in order to ensure the optimal running of the mission

- Supervising and organizing the daily activities of the Supply Chain team, specifically warehouse, and ensuring they perform the tasks linked to their role
- Being responsible for the order, purchase, stock and freight management in the coordination or in the project level, monitoring and ensuring an efficient implementation of the overall daily supply chain activities
- Monitoring and ensuring a smooth running supply administration and the respect of the implemented supply procedures, proposing adjustments where needed.
- Being responsible for the supply database and the correct filing and archiving of the supply documentation in order to guarantee the availability and the coherence of supply data
- Communicating with customers, keeping them up to date concerning their orders status (BO confirmation) and prio-ritizing procurement and transport according to their needs
- Collecting claims from the field, analysing causes and making corrective actions.
- In collaboration with the Supply Supervisor (if any) and in coordination with the HR department, supervising the as-sociated processes (recruitment, training/induction, briefing/debriefing, evaluation, potential detection, development and communication) of the staff under his/her responsibility in order to ensure both the sizing and the amount of knowledge required
- Informing the Logistics / Supply Manager in case of any major issue and draws-up all required reporting, in order to keep updated and reliable information that will help in decision-making
- Performing any other tasks within the scope of his role, as directed by supervision and according to the needs of the mission

MSF Section/Context Specific Accountabilities

• Managing warehouse team, making stocks reports, Focal point for communication related to stock with coordination and projects teams.

- Making sure,MSR,TSR and all unifield stock reporting are generated and shared with concerned people and departments.
- Working with procurement team and learning procurment process and unifield procuremnet section and support team once required.
- Act a a gap filling for supply chain officer for procurment by leaning all MSF tools and templates.
- Supporting Projects teams and act as gap filling if required for MSF projects in the field.
- Conducting spot checks in the warehouse and making sure all records are perfectly maintained in physical files and in the Log Admin kit.
- Building the capacity of warehouse tema in stock management and reporting and making sure to train warehouse staff so that they can gap fill his/her position in absence.
- Any task assigned by supervisor other than Job description for MSF work.
