### **ABOUT PUI IN SYRIA**

The current operational strategy for Premiere Urgence Internationale (PUI) in Syria is to alleviate the human suffering of the Syrian people in Syria by delivering sound, needs-based humanitarian assistance, while promoting a life-sustaining response. PUI's positioning on, shelter, education, livelihoods, and WaSH sectors remain a priority.

Based on ten years of experience conducting humanitarian operations in Syria, supporting Iraqi refugees and lately Syrians affected by the crisis, PUI has played an important role in responding to the needs of the population within nine governorates (Aleppo, Damascus, Rural Damascus, Homs, Hama, Tartous, Latakia & Deraa ) and through the following interventions:

- Rehabilitation of collective and private shelters,
- Rehabilitation of infrastructure
- Emergency and Early Recovery WASH interventions
- Education support for conflict-affected populations (remedial classes, school rehabilitation, free exam preparations, summer class activities, community based initiatives and psycho social support),
- Enhancement of the Population of Syria self-reliance through livelihoods (vocational training course, provision of a professional tool kit ((PTK)).

### **GENERAL OBJECTIVE**

The Health Project Manager is responsible for the implementation and supervision of all health activities within the project, and manages PUI's human and financial resources dedicated to these activities.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS**

- **Programs:** He/She ensures qualitative implementation and monitoring of health program(s) falling under his/her responsibility, while respecting PUI's health policy and intervention framework, and applying the key principles of protection mainstreaming.
- **Human Resources:** He/She supervises the Health Team (PUI salaried employees and, as the case may be, daily paid workers).
- **Logistics and Administration:** He/She ensures compliance of activities falling under his/her responsibility with logistical and administrative procedures.
- **Representation:** He/She represents the association before partners, authorities and local actors involved in the implementation of health programs.
- **Safety:** He/She contributes to efforts aimed at ensuring compliance with safety rules at the site, and transmits all information relating to safety concerns to his/her immediate supervisor.

- **Strategy:** He/She contributes to the development of new interventions on the basis of identified needs.

**SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES AND LINKED ACTIVITIES**

**1- Programme Implementation & Monitoring**

- Ensure beneficiaries and local populations understand project objectives and actively participate in implementation
- Plan activities and ensure timelines are met; report delays and propose solutions
- Work closely with the Health Coordinator on strategy, technical decisions, and reporting
- Ensure compliance with project objectives and performance indicators
- Monitor and analyze epidemiological data
- Conduct needs assessments related to pharmaceutical supplies (drugs, consumables, equipment)
- Ensure implementation of monitoring and evaluation activities
- Analyze collected data and share with relevant stakeholders
- Ensure proper archiving of project documents and verification sources
- Submit internal and external reports within deadlines (SitRep, donor reports)
- Contribute to mission monthly and quarterly health reports
- Ensure compliance with PUI health policy and intervention framework
- Submit requests for new health activities when needed
- Ensure integration of protection, gender, and inclusion approaches
- Promote gender equality and health equity across all interventions

**2- Team Management**

- Ensure team awareness and compliance with PUI Internal Rules
- Prepare job descriptions and participate in recruitment and termination processes
- Ensure regular performance evaluations
- Establish coordination mechanisms and supervision structure
- Identify training needs and organize capacity-building activities
- Develop and maintain team organizational chart

**3- Logistics & Financial Management**

- Identify and communicate needs for pharmaceutical supplies in line with budgets
- Ensure procurement requests are realistic and aligned with procedures

- Contribute to supplier selection and tender processes
- Ensure appropriate storage of medical supplies
- Communicate logistical needs (vehicles, communication tools)
- Organize delivery, distribution, and storage processes
- Provide inputs for monthly cash flow forecasts
- Monitor budgets, identify discrepancies, and propose adjustments

**4- Ensure Representation of PUI Before Health Actors**

- Represent PUI before local actors and maintain good relationships
- Participate in coordination meetings
- Support preparation and organization of donor visits

**5- Safety & Risk Management**

- Ensure team compliance with safety plans and procedures
- Report safety concerns and incidents
- Ensure activities do not put beneficiaries or staff at risk
- Ensure availability of appropriate safety equipment (e.g. PEP kits, gloves)

- Identify health needs with Field Coordinator
- Contribute to the design of project proposals
- Support development of gender-sensitive health programs
- Participate in mission strategy development
