Main Objective of the position:

Carrying out assessments and ensuring the implementation, maintenance and monitoring of the technical work in the projects within the specialization of Construction Engineering according to MSF protocols and standards in order to ensure an optimal running of the project and its infrastructures and the efficient use of the systems and equipment

Accountabilities:

- Defining procedures and ensures the implementation, monitoring, maintenance and correct functioning of the technical work within his/her area of specialization
- Managing the technical activities in support to and in close collaboration with the field responsible of the sector of activity (s)he is primarily in support.
- Carrying out assessment and feasibility studies in the project to provide line managers with alternatives and possible solutions to infrastructure challenges in the area of specialization e.g. installing / building / implementing. Liaising directly with the staff to identify the project needs and managing response and prioritization of requests.
- Where standard protocols are not available or appropriate, developing a protocol seeking extensive feedback and pilot tests to ensure its functioning as well as defining functioning standards and monitoring systems.
- Ensuring the proper documentation, filing and the compilation of the installation and maintenance done or required
- Acting as a technical referent, providing technical advice and oversight of quality and strengthening knowledge of the team. Providing training sessions to technicians, the managers and supervisors in the overall set-up, use and maintenance of new installations
- When required, acting as Flying expert in a mission and providing deep technical advice to managers

Performing delegated tasks specific to her area of speciality and as defined in his/her job description.

MSF Section/Context Specific Accountabilities

- Support the implementation of rehabilitation and construction projects as required by the mission.
- Prepare detailed Bills of Quantities (BOQs) and technical specifications for construction and rehabilitation works.
- Update and revise technical drawings, plans, and construction documents to support project activities upon request.
- Conduct site visits and inspections to monitor construction progress and ensure compliance with quality standards, technical specifications, and project requirements.
- Participate in technical discussions and assessments to identify construction-related needs in coordination with the Project Logistics Manager.
- Provide technical support throughout the planning and implementation phases of construction activities to ensure timely and effective project delivery.
