Main objectives	<p>Defining, coordinating and monitoring all mobile health activities to support health programs (HIV/TB, population displacement, epidemics...), according to MSF protocols, standards and procedures in order to ensure quality medical care for patients and their communities and to improve the health condition of the population.</p> <p>The activity involves operating a mobile clinic with regular morning and evening movements four days per week, and one dedicated day for reporting.</p>
Main responsibilities and tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure clinical monitoring and evaluation of the existing IDP population in the four locations. Conduct medical consultations for acute cases as needed and refer patients to the appropriate health services. Ensure a clear referral pathway and service mappings Carry out epidemiological surveillance, including detection of acute epidemic diseases, participate in investigations, and actively share findings with the Directorate of Health. Participate on making proposal, rapid and in-depth assessment, emergency response of any needs or gaps Participate in the implementation of the medical activity and be responsible to ensure activity chronogram is respected and timeline are met Team management , including organization of capacity building , performance , follow up of their objectives achievement etc Ensure proper coordination with different actors , etc Ensure smooth running of the daily activities in different locations Participate in the Reporting , including weekly reports, and monthly reports, etc Participate in the activity closure of activity in any location, with different team members Participate in meeting within MSF, and also upon delegation of line manager to attend clusters, organization meetings,...etc.
