Main responsibilities	
Place of work:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Damascus This position requires high mobility within Syria and readiness to deploy rapidly to emergency locations.

Contract of Employment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Service Agreement for 1 month, renewable.
Main objectives	Implement gynecological and obstetrician procedures, performing any other prior treatment required, during or immediately after a woman has given birth in order to improve women's reproductive health and to reduce pregnancy, delivery and neonatology risks. This will be done in accordance with MSF policies, protocols and universal hygiene standards and in multidisciplinary collaboration with other medical doctors and midwife services.
Main responsibilities and tasks	<p>The Medical Emergency Response Team (MERT) team of MSF Spain is working to respond to the various emergency situations that may occur across the country. The work will be run in different settings (camps, tents, buildings...) and very likely in different cities.</p> <p>The person should be ready and flexible to work on different and difficult conditions.</p> <p>The role ensures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Providing medical consultations and capacity building for the team members and to our collaborators from DoH. Participate in new assessments and participate in reports. Participate in external and internal meetings if needed.
