Place of work:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Damascus • This position requires high mobility within Syria and readiness to deploy rapidly to emergency locations.

Contract of Employment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Service Agreement for 1 month, renewable.
Main objectives	<p>Providing nursing care, treatment and follow-up of patients, according to doctors' prescriptions, protocols applied in service and universal hygiene standards/precautions, in order to ensure the quality and continuity of care for the targeted population.</p>
Main responsibilities and tasks	<p>The Medical Emergency Response Team (MERT) team of MSF Spain is working to respond to the various emergency situations that may occur across the country. The work will be run in different settings (camps, tents, buildings...) and very likely in different cities.</p> <p>The person should be ready and flexible to work on different and difficult conditions.</p> <p>The role ensures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing nursing care and performing triage. • Assisting the doctor during medical consultations. • Following medical prescriptions and keeping registers updated. • Maintaining good collaboration with team members and our collaborators from the DoH.
